Some of the world's most famous fashion designers did not actually study fashion. To name a few Diane Von Fustenberg majored in economics, Victoria, beckham, Gwen stefani and kanye west are singers turned designers and Miuccia prada has PH.D.in political science apparently made her career switch, currently helming both Italian luxurious brands prada and MIU.

They do not sew, embroider, knit, pattern cut or sketch. They simply tell their assistants what they want. However, this may result in potential pitfalls where it may restrain one's creative process due to the lack of technical skills. Drafting and sewing are still integral to fashion designing, one would have to study these modules to get an insight to fashion designing'', said leong yao wen, second year fashion design student from LASSELE college of the arts said.

First what is fashion?

Fashion is a term used interchangeably to describe the creation of clothing, footwear and accessories and cosmetics, and jewelers' of different cultural aesthetics and their mix and match into outfits that depict distinctive ways of dressing[style and trends]as signifies of social status, self-expression and group...

Fashion style

It refers to [the collective aesthetic and cultural influences the shape the way people dress and present themselves] while fashion is often seen as a constantly [hanging and evolving trend, style is more personal and enduring, reflecting a person's individual tastes and preferences.

FASHION DESIGN

Fashion design is the art of applying design, aesthetics, clothing construction and natural beauty to clothing and its accessories. It is influenced by culture and different trends, and has varied over time and place. "A fashion designer creates clothing, including dresses, suits, pants, and skirts, and accessories like shoes and handbags, for consumers. He or she can specialize in clothing, accessory, or jewellery design, or may work in more than one of these areas."

Fashion designers work in a variety of different ways when designing their pieces and accessories such as rings, bracelets, necklaces and earrings. Due to the time required to put a garment out in market, designers must anticipate changes to consumer desires. Fashion designers

are responsible for creating looks for individual garments, involving shape, color, fabric, trimming, and more.

Fashion designers attempt to design clothes that are functional as well as aesthetically pleasing. They consider who is likely to wear a garment and the situations in which it will be worn, and they work within a wide range of materials, colors, patterns, and styles. Though most clothing worn for everyday wear falls within a narrow range of conventional styles, unusual garments are usually sought for special occasions such as evening wear or party dresses.

Some clothes are made specifically for an individual, as in the case of haute couture or bespoke tailoring. Today, most clothing is designed for the mass market, especially casual and every day wear, which are commonly known as ready to wear or fast fashion.

A fashion designer conceives garment combinations of line, proportion, colour, and texture. While sewing and pattern-making skills are beneficial, they are not a pre-requisite of successful fashion design. Most fashion designers are formally trained or apprenticed.

A technical designer works with the design team and the factories overseas to ensure correct garment construction, appropriate fabric choices and a good fit. The technical designer fits the garment samples on a fit model, and decides which fit and construction changes to make before mass-producing the garment.

A pattern maker (also referred as pattern master or pattern cutter) drafts the shapes and sizes of a garment's pieces. This may be done manually with paper and measuring tools or by using a CAD computer software program. Another method is to drape fabric directly onto a dress form. The resulting pattern pieces can be constructed to produce the intended design of the garment and required size. Formal training is usually required for working as a pattern marker.

A tailor makes custom designed garments made to the client's measure; especially suits (coat and trousers, jacket and skirt, et cetera). Tailors usually undergo an apprenticeship or other formal training.

A textile designer designs fabric weaves and prints for clothes and furnishings. Most textile designers are formally trained as apprentices and in school.

A fashion buyer selects and buys the mix of clothing available in retail shops, department stores, and chain stores. Most fashion buyers are trained in business and/or fashion studies.
